The mentored program was discussed and Bill Burkert will put together a program which he'll implement in the next month.

Increasing the match fees was discussed. All clubs voted to retain the match fee at \$3.00.

Because of the departure of Lebanon, the League will now have five clubs for the Indoor Season. This will require a new scheduling format to be presented at the Fall Meeting scheduled for 2:00 PM August 29, 2010 at CFG.
