

**Inter- County Rifle League
Special Rules in Addition to NRA Rules
November 6, 2006**

Criteria for Creating Rules

- A. Each club has one vote based upon participation during the shooting seasons. In the event of a tie vote, each league member will be allowed one vote. In this case, the voting requirement is based upon the eligibility for awards for the previous season.
 - B. The Rules Committee is the League Officers and the past President.
 - C. Rule additions or revisions such as positions, targets, scoring, etc., shall be submitted to the League Secretary 6 weeks prior to the meeting in order to notify all Clubs 4 weeks before the meeting. New rule changes that are brought up at the meeting shall be put on the agenda for the next meeting.
1. Scoring shall be done with both/all teams present. Home team only may plug doubtful shots. A magnifier light is permitted. Only one plug shall be used for the entire match. The visiting team(s) may supply a checker.
 2. Targets shall be official NRA targets. No Army targets.
 3. The shooter shall be given doubtful shots per NRA rule no. 14.3. Rejected challenge fees (\$1.00) shall be submitted to the league.
 4. With the exception of scoring personnel, any shooter plugging targets shall be disqualified. Scoring personnel should not score their own target. If necessary, a teammate may score the target.
 5. New shooters not on the roster prior to the first match of the season must shoot in 2 matches before their scores can count for the team. Eligible scores shall start with the third match.
 6. Juniors shall not be 21 prior to January 1. Seniors shall be 60 years old or older before the first match of the season. Notify the League Secretary of changes.
 7. Matches may be postponed due to inclement weather or fire only. These matches must be made up as soon as possible. A match shall be forfeited for any other reason unless snow dates. Notify the League Secretary promptly. Rosters may not be improved upon for make-up matches. Refer SOP 1.2.
 8. Chamber flags are required at all matches. Flags shall be inserted into the rifle chamber upon opening of the gun case. Rifles can be brought to the firing line when the shooters are called to the firing line by the Range Officer only. Chamber flags may be removed at the start of the preparation period. Chamber flags shall be inserted upon completion of firing or the call for a cease fire.
 9. Juniors who attend at least three matches will get a free League Banquet meal.
 10. Shooters with perfect attendance in either Indoor or Outdoor Matches will get a free League Banquet meal.
